through shares and bonds of social enterprises



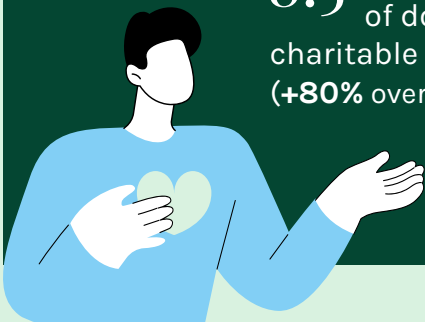
... rose by € 26 billion to € 30 billion as of December 31st, 2023



This represents 0.5% of French people's financial savings (compared to 0.45% in 2022)

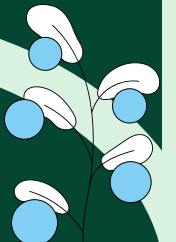
